

Through the phased felling of clearfell coupes the areas identified as PAWS will be allowed to regenerate with native broadleaf species.

Out with the areas designated for special treatment, the emphasis should be on developing a good commercial forest. Sitka spruce will be the preferred species but Douglas fir, European larch and Norway spruce will be considered where conditions are suitable for these species.

Good distant views of the FDP area from west Loch Linnhe and Corron Ferry. Design Coupes to enhance the landform and improve the general aesthetics of the drea.

The large area of open ground within the FDP area should be developed for native woodland expansion to produce a mosaic of native species to enhance the habitat for Henharriers, Black grouse and other native flora and fauna.

> Deer numbers should be kept at a level that will allow for the natural regeneration of native broadleaves.
