1. Valid entries are photos:
 - a. Submitted directly through the Forestry Commission Scotland's Facebook page or through Twitter, preferably using the hashtag #youknowitsautumn. Photos shared on other social media platforms, such as Instagram, will not be counted.
 - b. That include the location where the photo was taken.
2. Two entries per person allowed. We'll only consider the first two entries if you submit more than two.
3. The submission deadline is midday Thursday 27 October 2016 (UK time). We will then promote the shortlisted photos in a Facebook photo album by 5pm Friday, 28 October 2016. The public will have the opportunity to vote for their favourite photo and decide the winner by 'liking' their favourite photo from 28 October until midday Friday 4 November 2016.
4. Unfortunately if you live outside the UK we won't be able to send your prize to you, so the competition is only open to UK residents. You can still be part of the #youknowitsautumn conversation on Twitter though!
5. We would love to use your amazing autumn images on our website in the future, so by posting any images as entries to the competition, you are agreeing that the photo can be used by Forestry Commission Scotland in the future – with full credit to you.
