### Zones Map

- **Core Peat Areas:** Sensitive wet areas where the focus is on restoring peatland. Work will help store carbon, support wildlife, and improve natural water systems.
- **Commercial Focus:** Areas mainly managed for growing timber. Trees will be harvested and replanted to keep forests productive and healthy for the future.
- **Gulleys and Valleys:** Natural corridors around burns and low ground. Managed to protect water, support wildlife, and create connected habitats.
- **LISS Areas:** Forests managed in a continuous cover style, where trees are grown and removed gradually while younger trees take their place naturally. This keeps the forest looking more natural and supports wildlife and diversity.
- **Spey Valley Areas:** Areas near the River Spey, important for wildlife, scenery, and recreation. Careful management protects water quality, habitats and visitor experience.
