

**Possible resilience issues with narrow powerline corridor through mature broadleaves within SAC.**

**Very limited views of the forest are seen from the main access road. The neighbour at Drimlee will have the most prominent views of the woodland. More distant views are seen from the north and north-east, including from the access road to Loch Shira and path up Beinn Bhuidhe.**

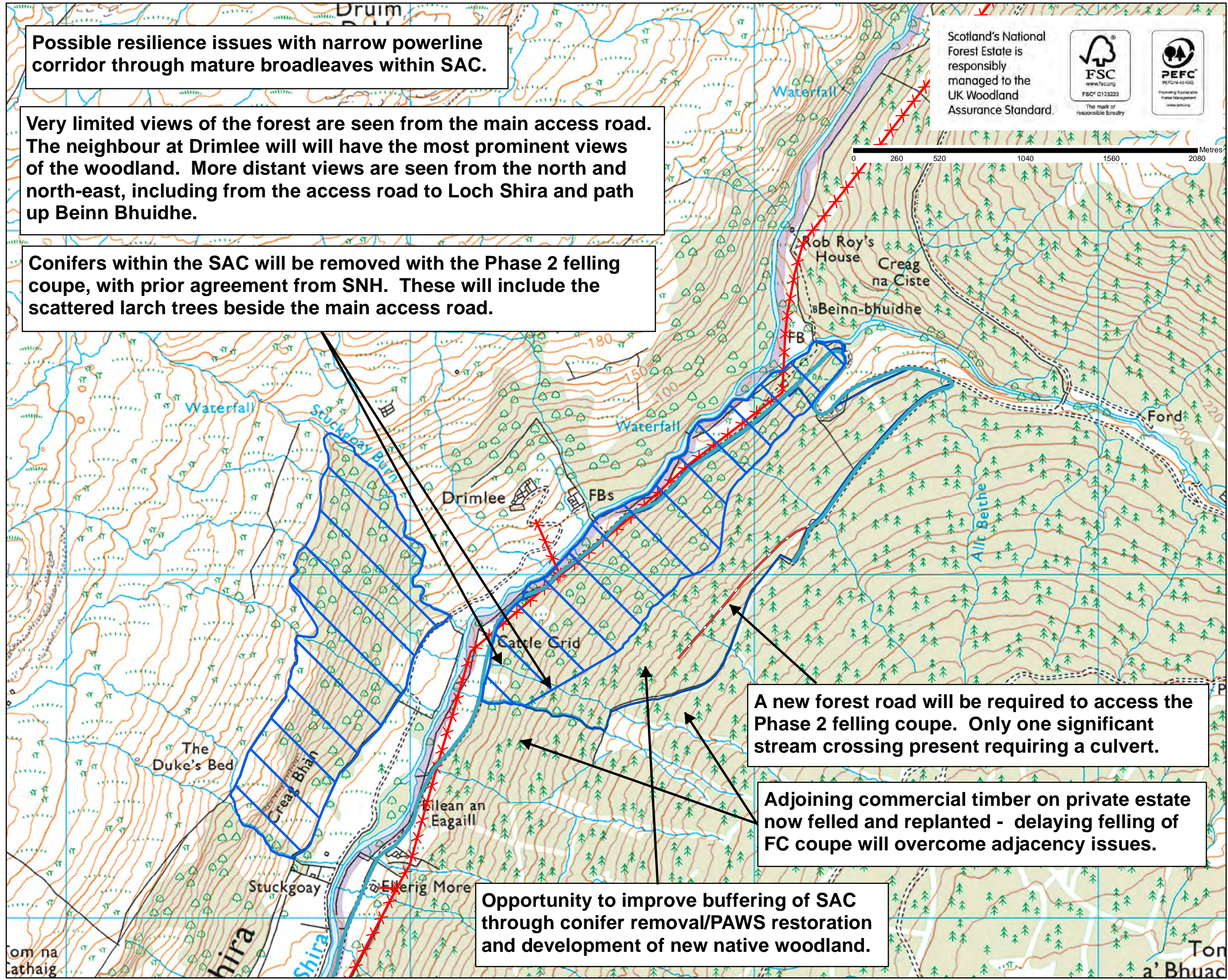
**Conifers within the SAC will be removed with the Phase 2 felling coupe, with prior agreement from SNH. These will include the scattered larch trees beside the main access road.**

**A new forest road will be required to access the Phase 2 felling coupe. Only one significant stream crossing present requiring a culvert.**

**Adjoining commercial timber on private estate now felled and replanted - delaying felling of FC coupe will overcome adjacency issues.**

**Opportunity to improve buffering of SAC through conifer removal/PAWS restoration and development of new native woodland.**
