



Nature Restoration Fund Project Map Accessible Text

Map showing location of riparian planting and fencing for the nature restoration fund project in Glen Prosen.

The Nature Restoration Fund Project in Glen Prosen aims to create 8.7ha of new riparian woodland creation and 155ha of natural regeneration in the River South Esk Special Area of Conservation.

Deer fenced enclosure for c.155ha natural regeneration plus riparian planting at Craigie Thieves/Kilbo - utilising existing fence lines where possible, with rabbit netting. Self-closing gates for ATV track and pedestrian/road access. Two water gates over Prosen Water.

Riparian planting within deer fenced enclosures along Burn of Louie and Burn of Kilbo - 5 enclosures in each polygon (0.25ha total)

Old Craig riparian planting - deer fence mainly along existing stock fence, with rabbit netting. Watergate at Old Craig in footprint of the old one. ATV access gates and pedestrian/road gate. Offset electric fence along existing stock fence to tie onto plantation deer fence.

Runtaleave planting - deer fence with rabbit netting along south side of river. Utilise existing stock fences with rabbit netting and electric offset along north side.

Cramie - Cormuir riparian planting - enclosures of rabbit netted stock fence with deer stobs and 3 line wires.

Cormuir riparian planting - deer fenced enclosure with rabbit netting.
