

The Spey Mouth block is split into several thinning coupes which will be worked on a 7 or 10 year cycle. Most of the area will be thinned in order to improve timber quality, however there may be commercial areas that are not thinned. These include those with terrain issues, where the thinning window has been missed or the basal area is below the threshold figure.

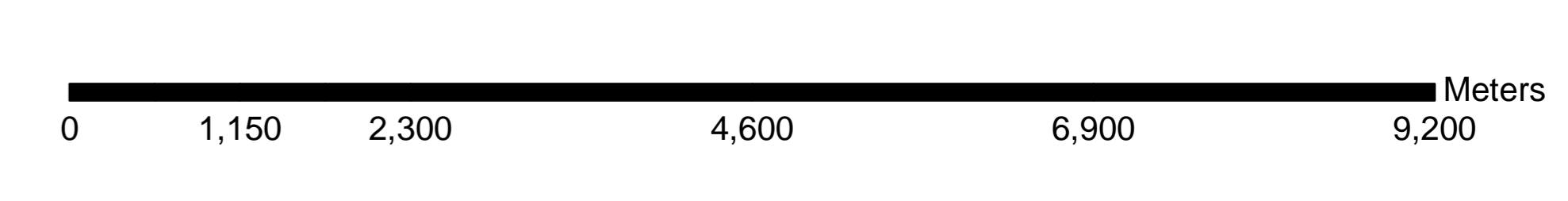
