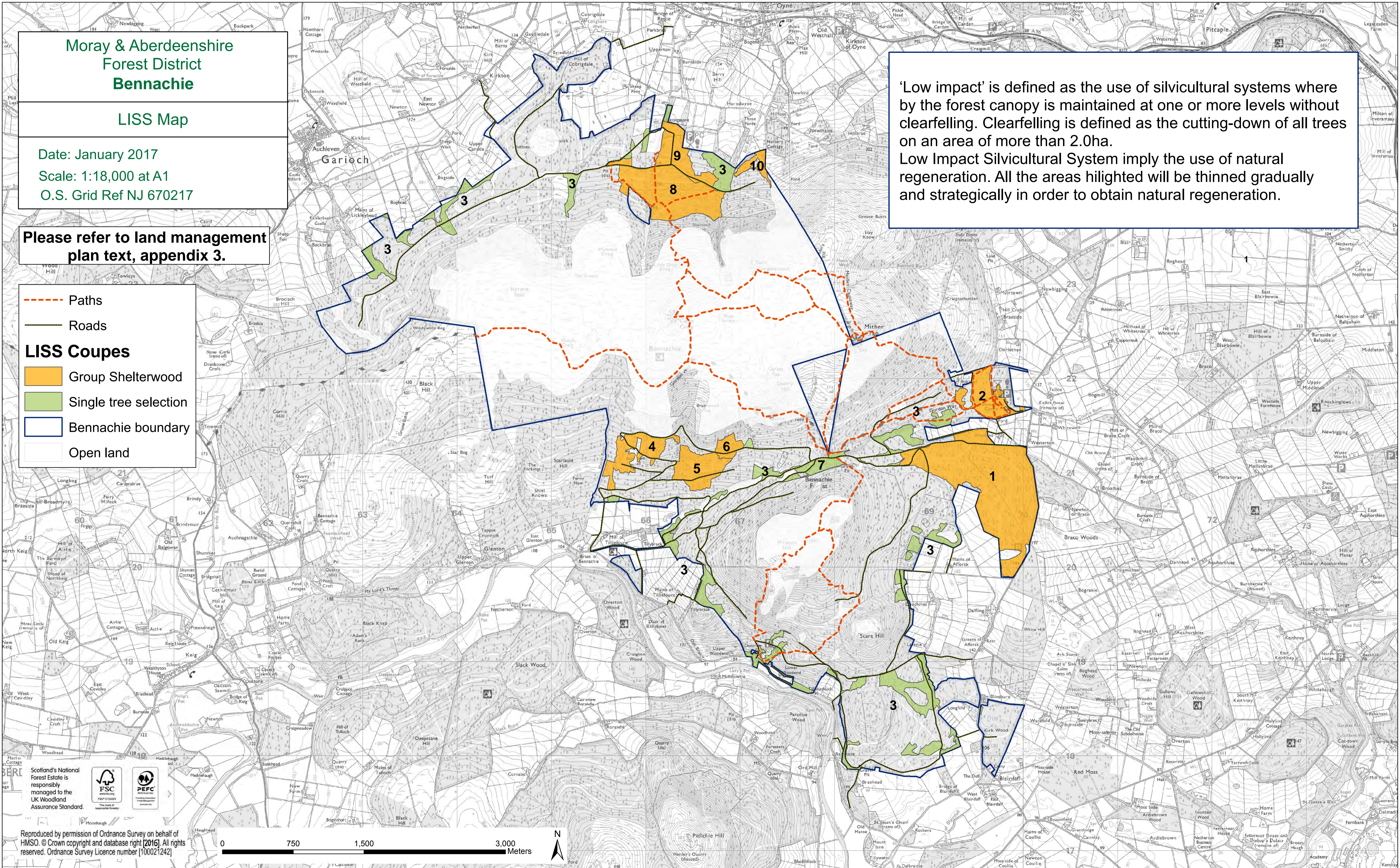

'Low impact' is defined as the use of silvicultural systems where by the forest canopy is maintained at one or more levels without clearfelling. Clearfelling is defined as the cutting-down of all trees on an area of more than 2.0ha. Low Impact Silvicultural System imply the use of natural regeneration.
