



South Loch Ness Land Management Plan Revision

Text Annotations on Map 2 Key Features

There are seven text boxes included on Map 2 each containing a key feature relating to the plan area. Each issue has been assigned a unique number on the map – in ascending numerical order north to south over the plan area – and this number has then been replicated in the text below.

To make this information accessible to people using screen reading technology the exact text of each itemised issue is given here. An additional sentence has been added at the end of each issue to describe where on the map the number(s) has been placed.

1. Vegetation beside parking areas to the side of the B852 to be managed to maintain views of Loch Ness. *Label placed at the north end of the B852 within FLS landholding.*
2. Urquhart Castle is one of the most popular visitor attractions in the Highlands of Scotland and provides views of the Erchite section of the forest. *Label placed at Urquhart Castle on the west side of Loch Ness, 2km east of Drumnadrochit.*
3. Scheduled ancient monument of Dun Deardail. *Label placed at Dun Deardail on the hill 500m east of Inverfarigaig in South Loch Ness.*
4. Larch above B852 to be felled to increase resilience and protect infrastructure. *Label placed on slopes above B852 in South Loch Ness, opposite Urquhart Castle.*
5. Loch Bran SSSI Dragonfly Assemblage. *Label placed on Loch Bran which is found on the edge of a 200m high escarpment above Loch Ness, approximately 2km southeast of Foyers, in South Loch Ness.*
6. PAWS area within the Camus to be restocked with native broadleaves and managed with intention of enhancing and expanding neighbouring Ness Forest SSSI. *Label placed at the Camus, 3km southwest of Foyers in South Loch Ness.*
7. Loch Knockie SSSI and SPA for breeding birds. *Label placed on Loch Knockie which is found 3km southwest of Whitebridge in South Loch Ness.*
