

The following labels have been annotated to Map 2 with accompanying lines indicating the location of particular features or areas with key management issues within the Plan area:-

- *Open ground & native woodland area under crofting tenure.*
- *Strome Wood: forest trails and focus of management concordat with Fernaig Community Trust.*
- *Ardnarff - Stromeferry flank: mature productive forests on steep, unstable slopes above key public transport corridors (road and rail).*
- *Glen Udalain (east end) - extensive deforestation and peatland restoration area approved within last forest plan period.*
- *North side of Strath Ascaig: extensive and fragmented ancient woodland remnants within non-native conifer woodland.*
- *Carn Greannach SSSI/SAC - geological & biological value: active restoration management.*
- *Upland areas, mostly afforested, with peatland restoration potential.*
- *All forest blocks have recreational trails and some core paths: an important asset for locals and seasonal visitors.*
- *Steep, highly visible slopes with mature productive timber forest and remnant ancient woodland.*
- *Ard Hill: forest trails and geological SSSI.*
- *"Three Lochs" SAC and MPA: vulnerable offshore reef communities.*
- *Coille Mhor (SAC/SSSI oakwood) across shared boundary: high ecological value & active restoration management.*
- *Loch Achaidh na h'Inich - public water supply and SSSI-designated loch with scheduled ancient monument (crannog).*
- *Sean-chreag (galleried fort) - scheduled ancient monument.*
- *Loch Carron MPA - with sensitive flame shell reefs & maerl beds.*
