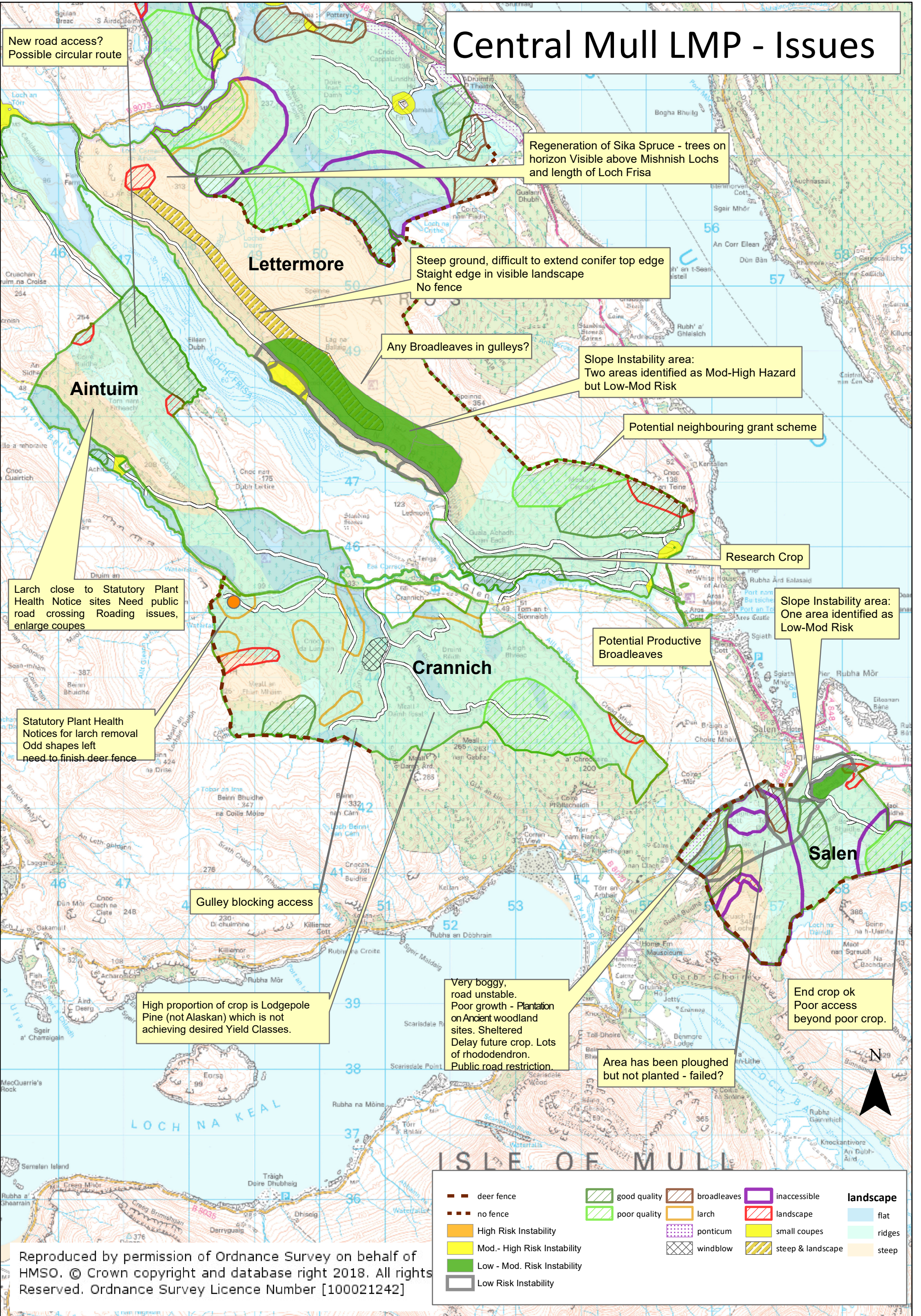


Central Mull LMP - Issues

Potential Productive Broadleaves

Crannich

Gully blocking access

High proportion of crop is Lodgepole Pine (not Alaskan) which is not achieving desired Yield Classes.

Very boggy, road unstable. Poor growth - Plantation on Ancient woodland sites. Sheltered Delay future crop. Lots of rhododendron. Public road restriction.

Area has been ploughed but not planted - failed?

End crop ok
Poor access
beyond poor crop.
