We will adjust the species mix to match the soil type:
- areas with drier soils in the western and central part will have Scots pine leading species
- wetter patches in the east will see an increase in spruce

Culloden Wood has a high percentage of brown earth soils:
- we will increase the amount of broadleaved trees in mixtures with Douglas fir and Sitka spruce and along riparian areas

Investigate 'scalping' planted edge either side of a section of forest road that runs south east to north west to provide a more open view towards Culloden House

Thin around the remaining two sections of Culloden dykes to give a more open woodland feel while retaining stability.

The area to the west of the Culloden Road and the eastern end of Westhill will be converted to native woodland and open space to reinforce landscape character around the battlefield
