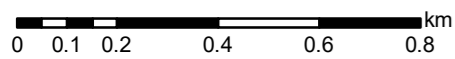

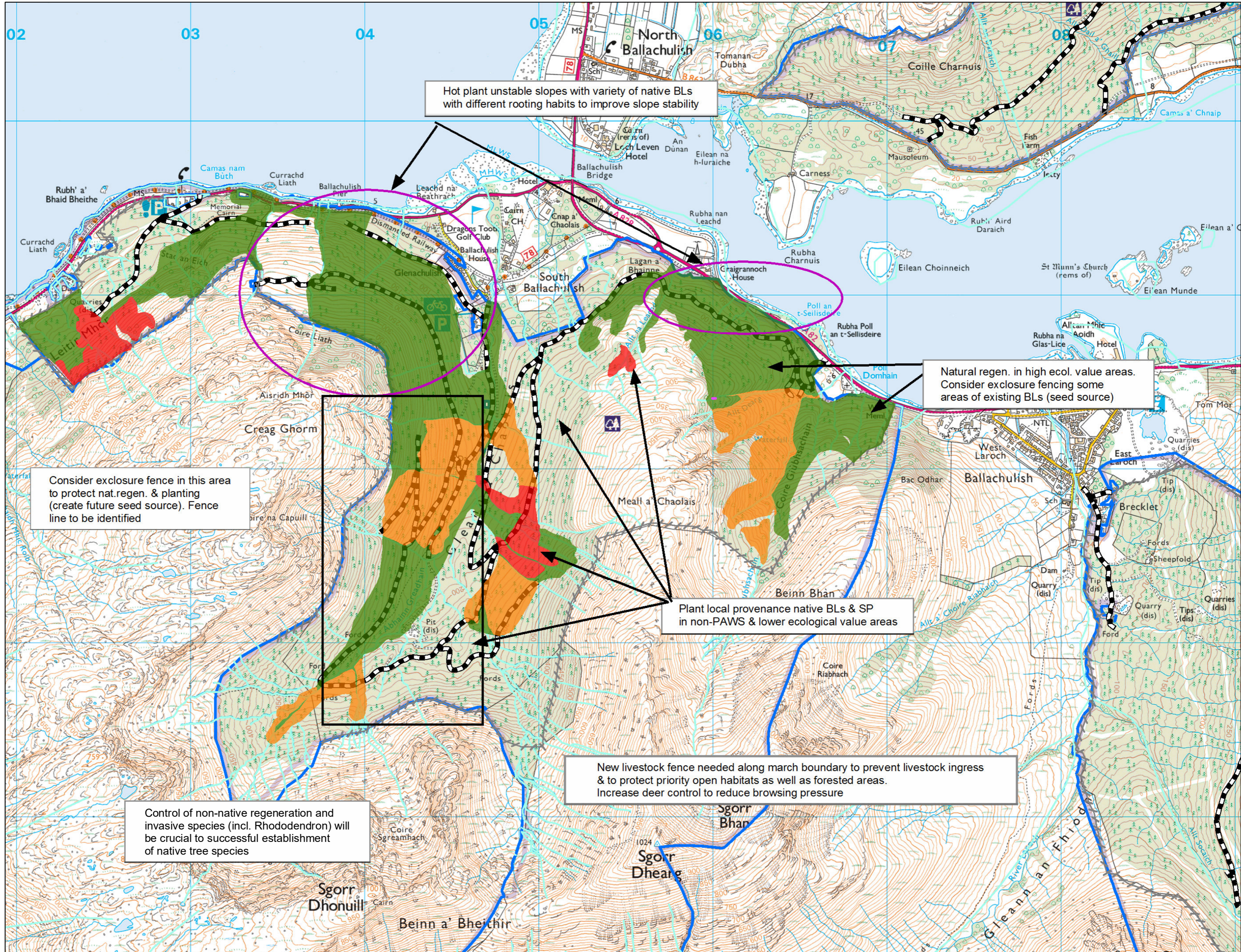

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Hot plant unstable slopes with variety of native BLs with different rooting habits to improve slope stability

Natural regen. in high ecol. value areas. Consider enclosure fencing some areas of existing BLs (seed source)

Consider enclosure fence in this area to protect nat. regen. & planting (create future seed source). Fence line to be identified

Plant local provenance native BLs & SP in non-PAWS & lower ecological value areas

New livestock fence needed along march boundary to prevent livestock ingress & to protect priority open habitats as well as forested areas. Increase deer control to reduce browsing pressure

Control of non-native regeneration and invasive species (incl. Rhododendron) will be crucial to successful establishment of native tree species
