Glossary of terms:

PAWS:	Plantations on Ancient Woodland Sites
INNS:	Invasive Non-Native Species
SPA:	Special Protection Areas
SSSI:	Sites of Special Scientific Interest

Management Objectives:

- 1) Continue with PAWS restoration and expansion of native broadleaf woodland
 - 2) Target removal of INNS (including non-native conifer species) in buffer zone around the Special Protection Area, and in the PAWS zone.
 - 3) Manage open hillside habitats as per the agreed Arran Moors SSSI / SPA Management Plans
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- Manage the Arran Moors SPA and SSSI as per the Designated Site Management Plans. Maintain the SPA areas as Open Space, and develop a buffer zone of fridge habitat.
 - Ensure the woodlands are regenerating and establishing as a diverse native woodland – enrichment plant if required
 - Maintain the quality of the visitor experience by managing a diverse woodland and offering views within and outwith the forest
 - Continue with the restoration of the PAWS area, and the expansion of native woodland throughout the site
 - Protect scheduled monument and other historic features
 - Consider the landscape impact. North Sannox is visible from the A841 road
