


**Keillour & Murrays Hill

Productive forest with areas of heathland to provide a range of habitats.

Mainly productive forest with a heathland influence which provides value for conservation.

Program appropriate coupes for clearfell.

Sequence coupes for clearfell.

Undertake visitor zone management at major public access points.

Update thinning coupe planner to ensure that thinning will take place.

Sequence restocking with suitable species to address riparian zone planting and sites cleared of windblow.

Productive conifer and broadleaves coupled with recreation interest.

Bring coupes under CCF prescription.

Remove remaining standing crop and include with sequenced coupe under phase 1.

Bring lochside broadleaves under management.

Productive forest with notable conservation component.

Remove up to 20m of internal roadside edge trees to improve forest roads, and create a more interesting place for visitors.

Reposition riparian zone to avoid access issues with forest road.

Apply a non thin policy for coupes with stability issues.

Consider internal crop drainage in order to improve stability.

Clearfell coupes which have gone beyond further thinning, and avoid periodic ground disturbance.
