## Location

Nearest postcode: IV14 9BT

**How to get here:** Blackmuir Wood car park is at the south end of Strathpeffer. If travelling from the south (Contin), the entrance sign for the car park is just after a large white building on the right hand side as you enter the village. If travelling from the north (Dingwall), continue through the village almost to the top of the hill - the entrance appears quite suddenly on your left hand side.

## Trail Information



#### Red Kite Trail



A short open loop with good views of Ben Wyvis and an opportunity to see kites and buzzards soaring above the edge of the forest.

Firm, largely wide gravel surface. Some uneven, loose and slightly grassy sections. Long moderate moderate % hour slopes for up to 700m

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#### Touchstone Maze Trail



Climb up to a remarkable stone labyrinth and find some far-ranging views across the mountains of the north.

Firm gravel surface throughout, with uneven and loose parts. Long moderate slopes for 700m and some slightly steeper sections.
