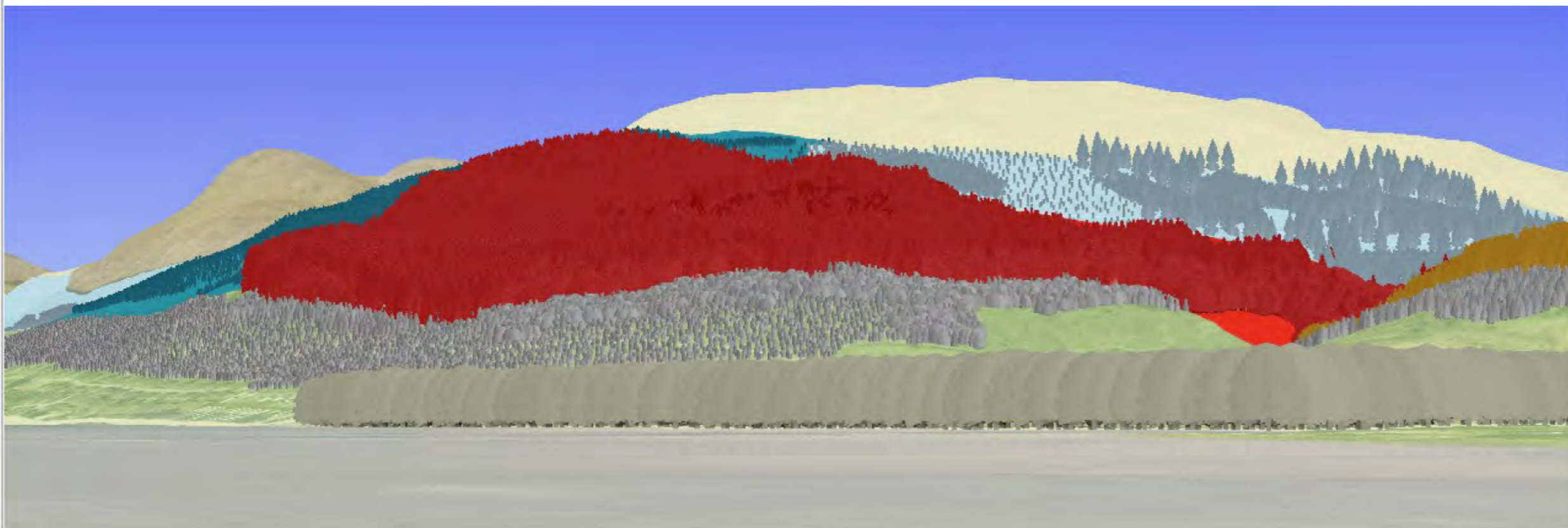

Phases: from 2025

Felling Phases have a rolling 5 year period and for visualisations start on the date shown above.



- Felled or fell year requires review
- Phase 1: < 5 years
- Phase 2: between 5 and 9 years
- Phase 3: between 10 and 14 years
- Phase 4: between 15 and 19 years
- Phase 5: between 20 and 24 years
- Phase 6: between 25 and 29 years
- Phase 7: between 30 and 34 years
- Phase 8: 35 years and greater
- Clearfell with seed trees
- Low Impact Silviculture
- Minimum Intervention
- Natural Reserve
- Long Term Retention
- Other/Open land
- Neighbouring woodland
