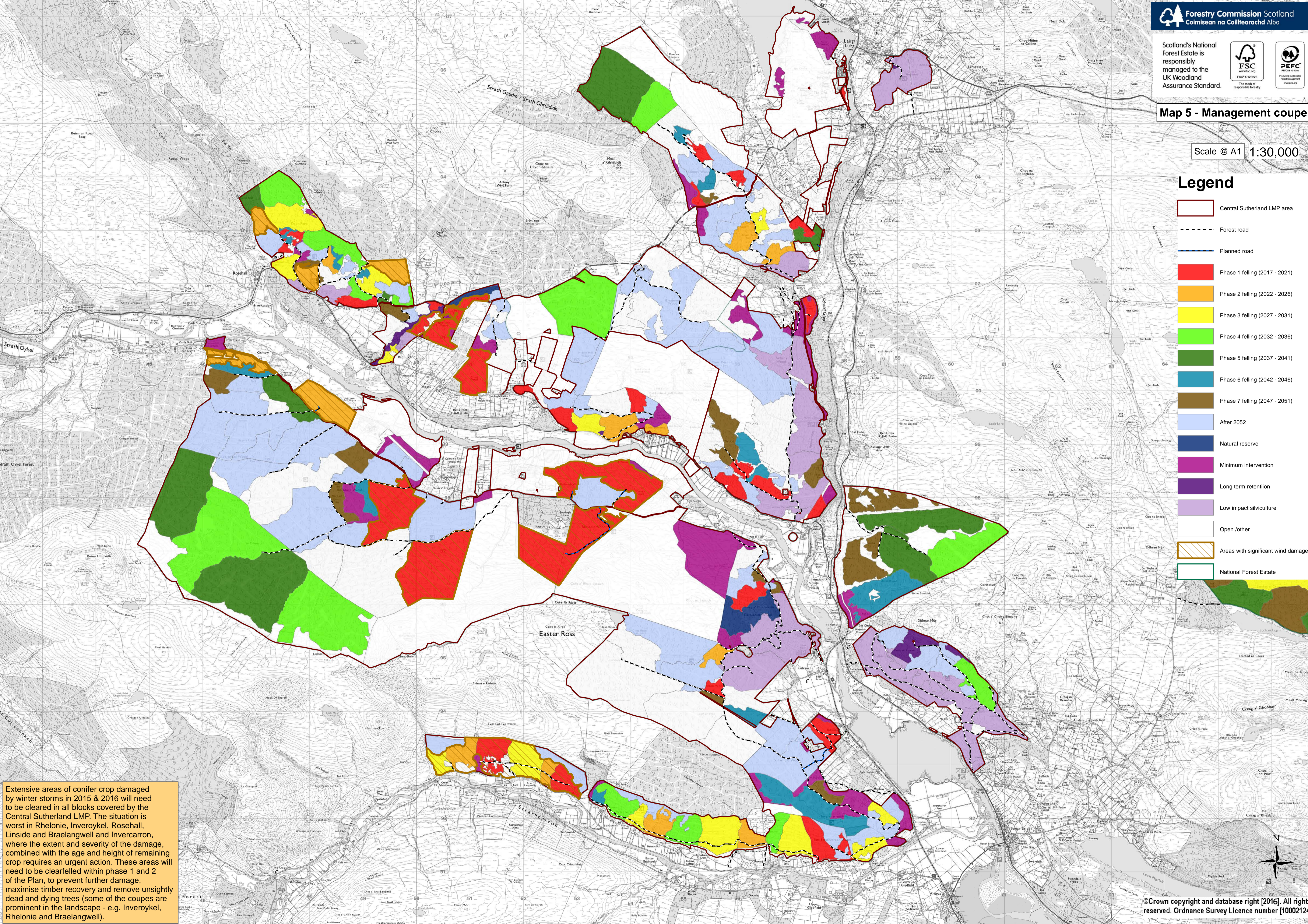


Map 5 - Management coupes

Extensive areas of conifer crop damaged by winter storms in 2015 & 2016 will need to be cleared in all blocks covered by the Central Sutherland LMP. The situation is worst in Rhelonie, Inveroykel, Rosehall, Linside and Braelangwell and Invercarron, where the extent and severity of the damage, combined with the age and height of remaining crop requires an urgent action. These areas will need to be clearfelled within phase 1 and 2 of the Plan, to prevent further damage, maximise timber recovery and remove unsightly dead and dying trees (some of the coupes are prominent in the landscape - e.g. Inveroykel, Rhelonie and Braelangwell).
