This Decision Notice relates to the asset transfer request made by STRATHERRICK AND FOYERS COMMUNITY TRUST LIMITED on 7 August 2023 in relation to Farigaig Forest School Building and car park, picnic area across the public road, and open land known as Fasnagruig Paddock shown on the indicative plan annexed, "the disposal area".

Forestry and Land Scotland has decided to agree to the request.

The reasons for this decision are as follows:

- Stratherrick & Foyers Community Trust identified acquisition of the Forest School
 Building and adjacent land in the Stratherrick and Foyers Local Place Plan to create a new
 community / visitor hub through community-led refurbishment of existing building and
 car park to form low-key trail base and heritage/nature learning centre.
- The request sets out a clear vision to secure the building and land for the community in perpetuity, revitalise the site and make it a 'home' for local volunteer led community

environmental projects and create a base and hub for at least three community-led environmental projects.

The attached document specifies the terms and conditions subject to which we would be prepared to transfer ownership of the land to you. If you wish to proceed, you must submit an offer to us at the address above by 12 July 2024. The offer must reflect the terms and conditions attached, and may include such other reasonable terms and conditions as are necessary or expedient to secure the transfer within a reasonable time.

Right to appeal

If you consider that the terms and conditions attached differ to a significant extent from those specified in your request, you may appeal to the Scottish Ministers.

Any appeal must be made in writing by 7 February 2024, which is 20 working days from the date of this notice, to:
