

Slattadale Land Management Plan

Annotations on Map 10 Landscape Context

There are eight different Landscape Character Types (LCTs) and two Wild Land Areas in and around the Slattadale Land Management Plan area. These are labelled and hatched on Map 10. The individual LCTs are defined below with their approximate location in relation to the Plan area.

- To the north of Loch Maree (and outwith Plan area): "Coastal Moorlands and Crofts" landscape character type.
- On the north-eastern (far side) of Loch Maree: "Rugged Mountain Massif" landscape character type.
- To the south of Talladale (and outwith the Plan area): "Wooded Glens and Rocky Moorland" landscape character type.
- South of the Plan area (on the hills/higher ground): "Rocky Moorland and Rugged Hills" landscape character type.
- South and west of the Plan area (on lower ground): "Wooded Glens and Rocky Moorland" landscape character type.
- To the north-west (on adjacent, upland area): "Cnocan" landscape character type.
- Further west from "Cnocan" LCT (i.e. outwith Plan area on lower ground): "Coastal Moorlands and Crofts" landscape character type.
- Much further south (beyond Plan-adjacent "Rocky Moorland and Rugged Hills" LCT): "Rugged Mountain Massif" and another "Coastal Moorlands and Crofts" LCT area.

The two Wild Land Areas (WLAs) exclude Slattadale LMP area - possibly on account of its designed, afforested landscape:-

- Area lying to the north and west of the LMP area: "Fisherfield-Letterewe-Fannichs" WLA.
- Area lying to the south of the LMP area: "Flowerdale-Shieldaig-Torridon" WLA.
