

Indicative management coupes & 10 year felling plan

Timber haulage will be exiting the forest directly onto main trunk roads (A82 and A809).

Coupe 63099 was recently felled and is now proposed for open mire restoration 16.2 hectares.

Coupe 63025 SS/HL p2012. Premature felling only to proceed if larch affected by Statutory Plant Health Notice (SPHN).

Coupe 63002 SS/HL p2010. Premature felling only to proceed if larch affected by Statutory Plant Health Notice (SPHN).

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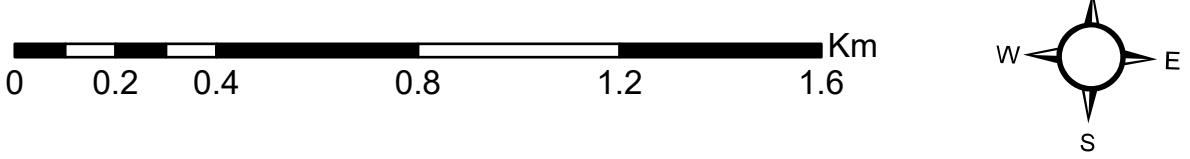
