



Accessible map text for Section 2: Timber transport on Arran

In 2019, FLS commissioned an Arran wide survey of potential timber export sites. Only a few of these sites were declared technically viable. Whitefield Farm was deemed one of the best options and was purchased by FLS in 2022. This map highlights both the constraints and opportunities at each site.
