Land Management Plan Process

- Details our objectives for next 10 years and beyond
- Ensures felling permissions for the next 10 years
- Ensures compliance with UKFS and UKWAS (FSC)
- Detailed 10 year plan of felling/thinning and restocking
- It does **not** detail site specific operational plans
- Current operations have previously been approved through similar processes and are currently not consulted on. We can give information about these operations though.



Land Management Plan process

- Scoping Oct 2024
- Drafting Nov/Dec 2024
- Consultation Jan 2025
- Submission Jan/Feb 2025

Background

- Previous plan ran from 2014-2024
- Large scale damage during Arwen and Corrie
- Subsequent felling and restocking
- Very well used for recreation
- Productive and well situated for timber markets
- Environmentally important (red squirrel, raptors, creeping ladies tresses)
- Key infrastructure in and around block (gas, electricity, trainline)



Objectives

- Maximise recovery of windblown crops
- Maximise area of Continuous Cover Forestry (CCF)
- Select species to enhance resilience and increase environmental and amenity value
- Protect scheduled monuments
- Protect key infrastructure and ensure resilience
