Viewpoint

There is no car parking at the start of the woodland trails here. We recommend that you park in the centre of Drumnadrochit - from here it's just a short walk of ¼ mile (500 metres) up to the start of the trails. Look out for waymarkers to 'Craigmonie Woodland Trails'.

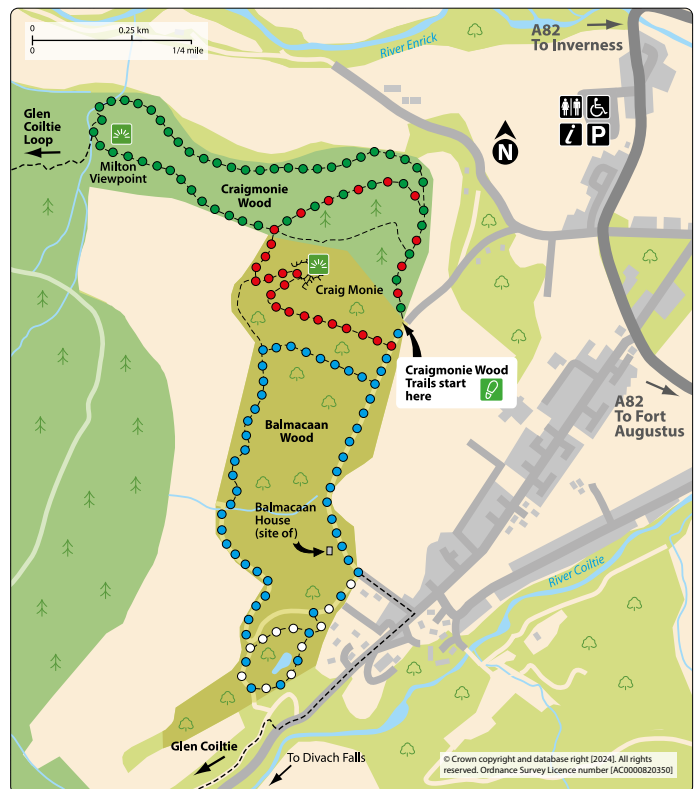
You'll find parking, toilets and places to eat, drink and shop in the village of Drumnadrochit.

Craigmonie lies just to the west of the village of Drumnadrochit, off the A82 on the western shore of Loch Ness.

Craigmonie Trail ●●●

Climb up to this historic hill for a great view over Urquhart Bay and Loch Ness.

A mix of firm gravel and earth paths, with some rough, narrow and muddy sections. Includes some exposed tree roots. Long steep slopes for up to 600m.

Milton Trail ●●●

Wander along the paths and try the wildlife quiz. Take a seat at the Milton viewpoint and discover the story of the village below.

A mix of firm gravel and earth paths with some rough surfaces and exposed tree roots. Long steep slopes for up to 400m.
