



Torran woodland creation

Torran woodland creation went through an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Screening Opinion Request (SOR), following surveys, options and consultation.

Scottish Forestry SF) deemed EIA “Consent not required” (CNR) on 18th December 2024, with the decision being valid for 5 years.

The woodland creation will create a native woodland on the lower areas of the land and open hill/priority open habitats on the upper hills.

143.22Ha Afforestation;

- 49.48Ha Natural regeneration
- 93.74Ha Planted- 80.45Ha mixed broadleaves and 13.29Ha Scots pine

Forested area 25%

Open land 75%
