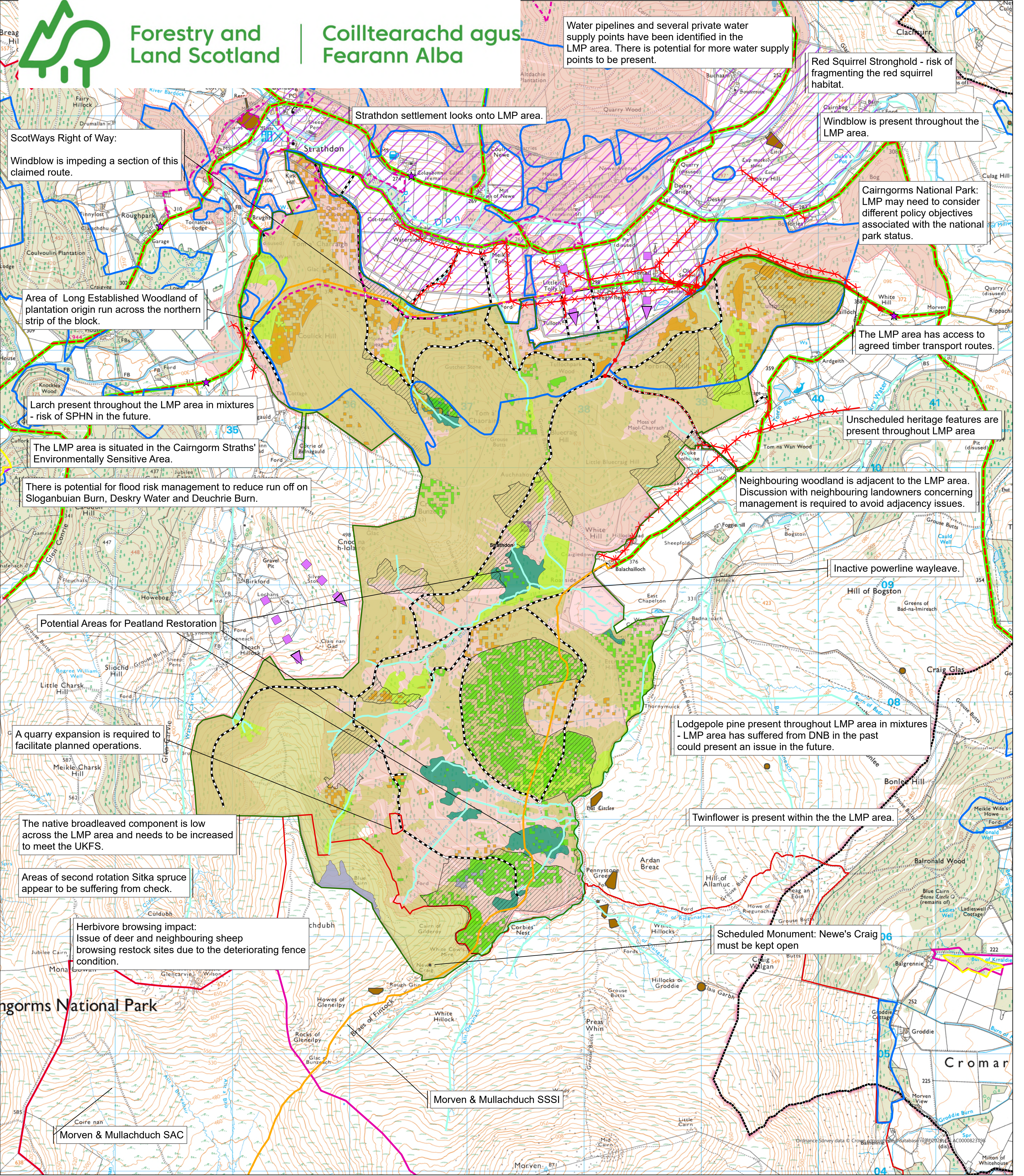

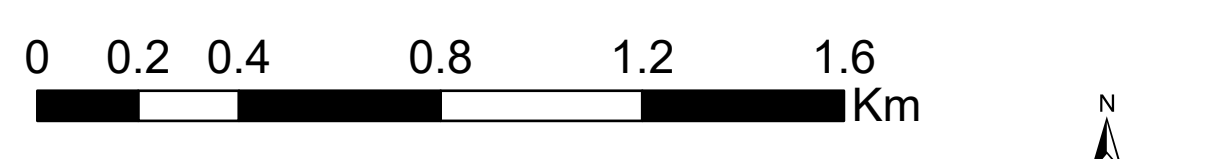
Map 2: Key Features and Issues
