




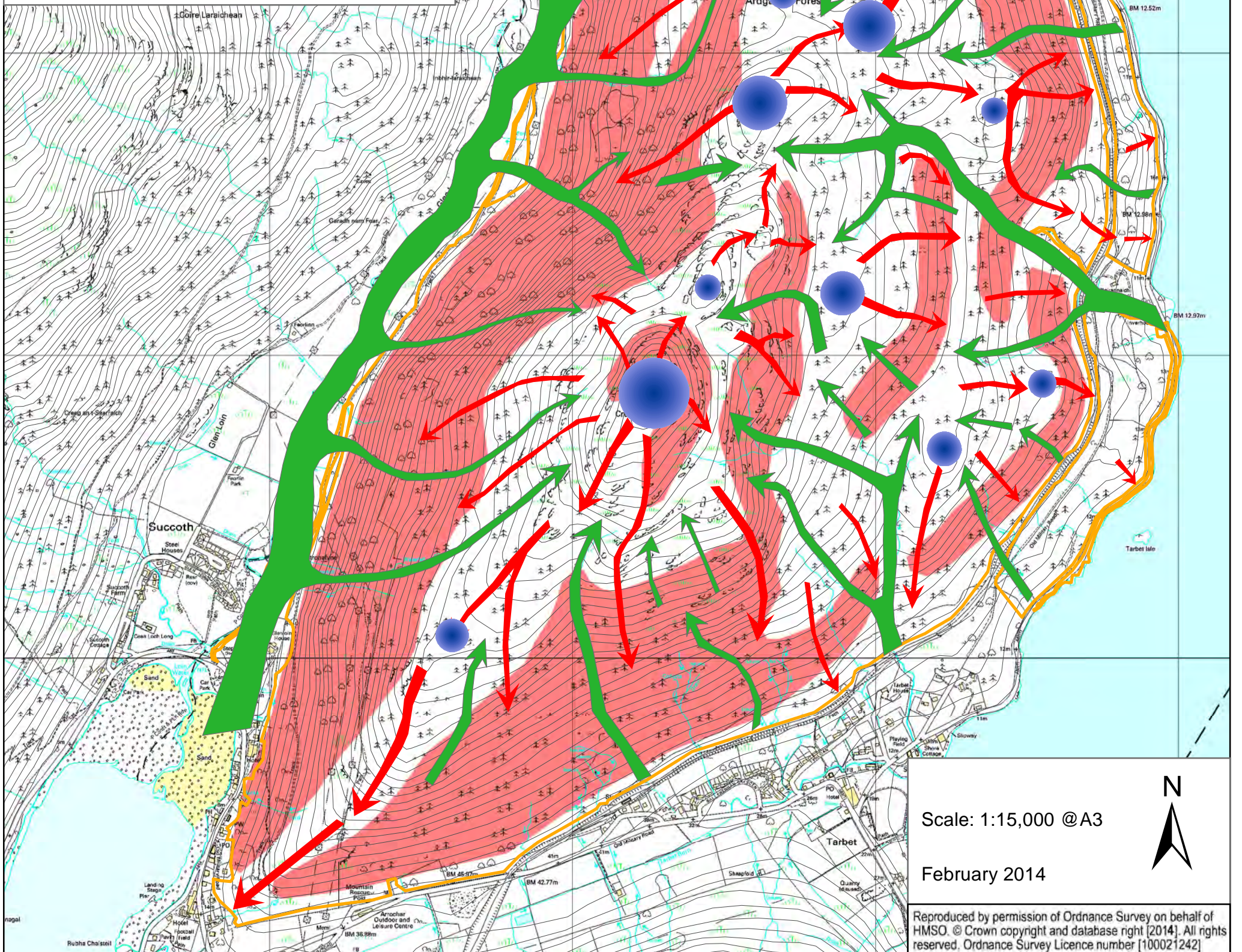


Map 4: Landform Analysis

Legend

-  Key summits & terraces
-  Eye follows down ridges
-  Eye is pulled up gulleys & hollows
-  Cruach Tarbeirt Forest Boundary
-  Steeper & more evenly graded slopes

The landform analysis of visual forces & the slope analysis together illustrate the complex topography of Cruach Tarbeirt. While some of the lower slopes are relatively even, they rise to a series of knolls, intervening gulleys and tiered benches creating a complex landform.
