From the A9, follow signs for Killiecrankie, then Kinloch Rannoch. Allean car park is on the right, $7\frac{1}{2}$ miles along the B8019, less than $\frac{1}{2}$ mile beyond Queens View Visitor Centre.

Trail Information


Clachan Trail 000

Climb steadily through varied forest to discover a 300-year old farming settlement and some superb views across the Tummel Valley.

Mostly wide, firm gravel surface. Uneven grassy section with some muddy patches. Includes some fairly steep slopes. Look out for vehicles along well-used forest roads.



1³/₄ miles / 3.0 km Allow moderate | 1 hour



Ring Fort Trail

Stretch your legs a little more and travel further back in time at an ancient Pictish ring fort.

Firm gravel surface throughout, with some uneven and slightly grassed over sections. One long steep slope. Includes a section along a well-used forest road.
