

Bloomery mounds from old iron works can be found throughout the forest block.

Remove non-native conifer within the Loch Lomond Woods Special Area of Conservation as per objective 2c. to "Restore the distribution and viability of typical species of the habitat"

Blocks lie within a national scenic area, a national park, and the Ben Lomond National Memorial Landscape designations. All management must be conducted with this in mind.

Restoration of temperate rainforest within the LMP area would potentially have a positive impact on neighbouring areas of conservation by removing non-native seed sources.
