



Areas with crops and sites conditions that are suitable are to be managed under LISS. All other areas have been planned for felling.

Areas with severe butt rot infections have been removed from LISS management and planned for felling. There is potential for adjacency between coupes as there is a large area of over mature even aged crops that need to be felled.

The coupe adjacent to Roscobie Park contains trees that have not been thinned previously and are therefore not suitable for management under LISS. This coupe will be clearfelled but the timing of the felling will be reassessed at the five year review to decide if felling is required given the condition of the trees and their proximity to neighbouring properties.
