








Riparian zones enhanced with more broadleaf planting, blending into a mixed Scots pine and broadleaf high forest that climbs up the slopes, providing diverse habitats for wildlife.

Scots pine and native mixed broadleaves planted at variable densities depending on topography and landscape features, allowing for future natural regeneration and naturalistic woodland habitat. Woodland disperses into more open heath and montane habitats at high elevation on steep rocky ground.

Crags and scree slopes on the outer edges of the forest will remain open, but with additional deer fencing to aid natural regeneration of scrub and potential for target planting of specialist montane species.
