



# Fonab and Grandtully Land Management Plan Public Consultation Response

I would like to thank everyone who took the time to consider the proposals put forward for the ongoing management of the forests of Fonab and Grandtully and for providing feedback during this consultation. As custodians of the National Forests and Land we are always interested to hear the views and opinions of the people who use our forests.

The consultation ran for a period of four weeks from the 29<sup>th</sup> March to the 25<sup>th</sup> April 2021. During this time we received 33 responses. Respondents were principally concerned with recreational access, restoration and protection of habitat and increased planting of native species. Detailed on the following pages is a summary of the feedback we received.

For the questions requiring a written response we have used word clouds to highlight the key topics that respondents were most interested in. A word cloud is a collection of words depicted in different sizes. The bigger and bolder a word appears, the more often it is mentioned within a given text and the more important it is.


The feedback we have received will be used to help develop our management proposals for these forests.
