

Forester

Restock felled area with Spruce. Leave the outer edge to the north of the burn unplanted but allow to regenerate naturally to provide a diverse edge.

Re-structure remaining mature crops in the central area once the recent restock has become established.

Central core of the woodland to remain as commercial spruce.

Retain existing areas of bog and open water.

Re-establish a diverse edge following clearance along the power-line.

Diversification of the woodland edge, retention of open space and internal structure of forest crops will improve conditions for black grouse habitat.

Begin re-structuring of the forest edges where these have been cut by the creation of road lines. Work to internal wind-firm edges.

Successor crop of Scots pine at commercial spacing at the southerly edges on drier sites. This will tie in visually with mature pine beyond the FC land holding.

Delay felling area of check. Some of the trees are recovering and the area is starting to develop a diverse structure.
