


Glen Doll Forest Design Plan

Date: January 2010



Improve landscape of upper margins and internal views from walks. Replant reduced area with a core of productive conifers, balanced with open space and floodplain woodland to link with native woodland to the north.

Improve landscape impact of this prominent area and retain core area. Replant with a mix of Scots Pine as productive conifers and a natural reserve with open space.

Manage this gateway facility to the National Park. Includes core recreation areas with car park, picnic area, ranger base and start of walks network (including long distance routes into the National Park). Continue to thin older areas to improve internal views and retain habitat value.

Increase area of open space to create an interzone between the forest and the open hill, including the National Nature Reserve. Retain clumps of re-thinned pine and larch to provide structural diversity and enhance internal views from paths.
