

## Summary of Land Management Plan Proposals

Lanehead Farm is a c. 58 ha of New Woodland Creation that lies approximately 6 – 7 km west of New Cumnock, East Ayrshire. Lanehead Farm will be incorporated into the nearby North Kyle Land Management Unit that lies north of the B741 Dalmellington to New Cumnock road in East Ayrshire at the next renewal date in 2024. The main management objectives for Lanehead Farm support the wider Land Management Plan objectives and focus on: sustainable timber supply and increasing biodiversity provision as well as protecting and conserving heritage features.
